Our objective is to familiarize ourselves with each property and their "defensiveness" in case of a house fire. During this process, we are pleased to offer you a summary of our observations, point out potential hazards and recommend corrective actions. Please feel free to contact a member of your Fire Department for additional details. For the sake of expediency, we are highlighting only the areas for which we have some concerns.

Situation	Corrective action required*
<input type="checkbox"/> Limbs/branches too close to chimney	*Trim back BEFORE using your stove or fireplace
<input type="checkbox"/> Cut branches or debris accumulations on lot	Take to the Transfer Site.
<input type="checkbox"/> Dead trees / danger to roof	Cut down before winter
<input type="checkbox"/> Branches over power line	Trim back before winter
<input type="checkbox"/> Fuel container(s) too close to house	Please store away from house
<input type="checkbox"/> Access to propane shutoff /tank obstructed	*Clear obstruction to allow access
<input type="checkbox"/> No street address or Lot #	Please install street address ASAP
<input type="checkbox"/> Vehicles parked within 20 feet of hydrant	*Remove vehicle and keep hydrant/standpipe clear
<input type="checkbox"/> Fire pit doesn't meet regulations	*DO NOT USE before regulations are met See web site for regulations
